Yukon Snowmobile Clubs

At this time we are optimistic that more local snowmobile clubs will be created or revived in the Yukon during the coming years. Wheels On Trails

Please do not operate wheel vehicles on multi-use trails between November 1st and March 31st of each year. Wheel ruts left in the snow are dangerous to other trail users. Also it often takes many hours of volunteer time for groomers to repair the snow base, time we don't get paid for and time we could have spent improving more trails. Wheeled vehicles on multi-use trails in Whitehorse can be reported any time to 867 667 2111.

Join Us For A Group Ride

We have one more group snowmobile ride planned for our members this season, and you're invited...

- We are planning to ride the Livingston Trail this Saturday 09 March 2024.
 - All are welcome to come along, however please note this will be a long day of riding on a remote wilderness trail with rough sections likely, so we recommend only experienced riders who are prepared for a long day attempt this ride.
 - Ride starts at 09:30 at the Lake Laberge Campground, and we expect to return to the campground late evening.
 - Estimating 100-200 kilometers total for the ride, please be prepared with fuel etc. for 200 km +.
 - Klondike Snowmobile Association volunteers will lead the way and bring up the rear, however all participants will be responsible for their own snowmobiles, riding gear, fuel, food, etc.
 - We'll be stopping for short breaks at several points of interest so we highly recommend participants bring some snacks, drinks and a light lunch.
 - Helmets and safe riding are mandatory for all Klondike Snowmobile Association group rides.
 - This ride may be postponed on short notice if weather or trail conditions are not suitable on the morning of the ride, please check our website or facebook on the morning of the ride for confirmation.
