Trans Canada Trail Cleanup

Following our recent strategic planning process, the K.S.A. is seeking to engage more closely with the community and increase volunteer activity on the multi-use trail network.

We recently reached out to the Crestview Community Association with a proposal to collaborate on some seasonal maintenance of the Crestview Bypass section of the Trans Canada Trail in Whitehorse, and they rallied a number of Crestview residents to come on out and help. Led by experienced K.S.A. trail stewards running chainsaws, brush saws and pole saws, this crew removed brush and trees from the trail and picked up any garbage they found on the trail over a series of three evenings in late May/early June. This effort amounted to about 45 person-hours of labour and significantly improved the Trans Canada Trail around Crestview.

Once the work is complete the trail will be returned to it's usual condition and opened again for your multi-use enjoyment.
