Copper Haul Fire Break Update

Starting in October 2025 and continuing through Summer of 2026, fire break work will be happening on and around the Copper Haul Road between the Mount Sima Road and McLean Lake Road.

About 70 hectares of vegetation will be cleared over the winter, the area will be cleaned up, and then fire-resistant aspen seedlings will be planted during the summer of 2026.

Public access to the Copper Haul Road will remain open. The usual closure to wheeled traffic from November 1st through March 31st will continue to apply. One lane of the road will be plowed during winter for crews and equipment to use and one lane will be left snow covered for all of the usual winter uses.

Please slow down and use extra caution when snowmobiling in this area this winter. Expect narrow sections, crews and equipment on and near the trail, and occasional temporary plowings or closures. We thank everyone in advance for their patience and understanding.
